

Particulars of organization, functions and duties.

The Main functions of the Central Council are maintenance of Central Register of Homoeopathy and for matters connected therewith like –

- i) To lay down minimum standards to be observed in Homoeopathic education;
- ii) To recognise Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital
- iii) To recommend recognition or withdrawal of medical qualification granted by Homoeopathic Medical Institutions in India to Central Govt.
- iv) To negotiate with institutions located in other Countries imparting training in Homoeopathy for recognition of other qualifications on reciprocal basis.
- v) To recommend approval to the new colleges, now/ higher courses and / or for increase in the intake capacity in existing Colleges.
- vi) To lay down the standards of professional conduct, etiquette and code of ethics to be observed by the practitioners of Homoeopathy

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973, the Central Council has taken expeditious steps towards putting the medical education in Homoeopathy and practice on a proper footing keeping in view the national requirements. It has introduced with the prior sanction of the Central Govt. the following educational Regulations for Diploma, Degree and Post Graduate Degree Courses for maintaining uniformity of medical education in All India level.
