Madam/Sir,

The Board of Governors of Central Council of Homoeopathy in its meeting held on 18.06.2020 noted the provisions of Section 26(1) of HCC Act, 1973 which permit every qualified registered practitioner whose name in for the time being borne on Part-I of the Central Register of Homoeopathy, to practise Homoeopathy in any part of India. Thus, there is a need to discourage such registered practitioners from submission of application in Form A, for Direct Registration in CCH whose names are already entered in the Central Register of Homoeopathy.

The applicants who are registered with State Board / Councils but their names are yet to be taken in the Central Register of Homoeopathy, be informed their details after taking their names in the CRH in the similar manner as decided above.

The Registrar may continue to issue registration certificate in Form C, on receipt of application in Form AA from those qualified Homoeopathic Doctors who are residing in States, where no State Board / Council exist and they do not posses any State Registration.

In view of above, it is requested to apprise above provisions to the Homoeopathic Practitioners who are registered / apply for registration with your Council.
